**NEWS FROM OUTREACH**

Aid for Friends - Breakfast Bags are an annual event for the Outreach Committee. Normally, during the month of June and July we collect funds for items to be distributed in August. These items consist of small boxes of cereal, juice, packets of oatmeal, cocoa, crackers cookies, boxes of

raisins, small containers of fruit and Jello, tea bags, etc. Since most of these items can be purchased in bulk, we do far better by collecting the money and doing the shopping. These items are packaged for delivery to the frail and home bound folks in our area. These are folks that for one reason or another cannot shop for themselves and are dependent upon food being delivered. This is a service done by Aid for Friends through their many co-ordinators and churches in the area. This is a service that takes place twelve months out of the year supported by the schools and groups in the area as a community service. Traditionally, we have chosen August as schools and service groups are shut down for the summer and BB's are in short supply. Again, BB's will be assembled in August.
